



HOMESTAY PLACEMENT AND SUPPORT SERVICES

DIRECTORS & COORDINATORS

ACP Directors oversee the full program and lead local area and school coordinators. These local coordinators support students and host families for each school. This allows us to provide support and care for the student within each school teams. Coordinators and Directors work together to find, screen, train and support the host families for our students.

OVERSIGHT & VETTING

Homestay families are vetted extensively and require 3 references, photos, and a background check. The coordinators also visit and inspect the house and complete a report for review by Directors and parents. The coordinator will also train new families on cultural differences and how to be create a living environment that is comfortable for the family and the student. They also mediate any problems that families and students might encounter.

OUR FAMILIES

Families are not recruited on an open market, rather we search from within the school community and often receive host families from referral. This helps ensure a safer and more contained environment. ACP's coordinator is part of the relationship with the school so that they have access to student's grades. This allows ACP to provide reports to the student's natural parents. The coordinator will also help mediate with the school should the student have any issues.

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
